

[Brazil as an exporter of social technologies](#)

The book “Bolsa Família Program: a decade of social inclusion in Brazil”, organized by the minister of the Secretariat of Strategic Affairs of the Presidency of the Republic (SAE) and president of the Institute for Applied Economic Research (IPEA), Marcelo Neri, and by minister Tereza Campello, from the Ministry of Social Development (MDS), has earned a shorter, bilingual version containing the most important information of its original 29 chapters. Authors of various disciplines and areas of study produced this summary: from anthropology and medicine to themes such as impacts over education, labor, health and macroeconomics; institutional details of the Single Registry for Social Programs (Cadastro Social Único) and the articulation between levels and spheres of government. The purpose of these new publications is to promote, internally and abroad, the diffusion and exchange of knowledge on the country’s main social technology program in recent years and to serve as a model for similar initiatives throughout the world.

This executive summary is the first publication of the World Without Poverty: Brazil Learning Experience Initiative, also supported by the World Bank and the International Policy Center for Inclusive Growth (IPC-IG) of the United Nations Development Program (UNDP). The WWP aims to disseminate and share programs and actions from the entire world that have as their main objective the reduction of inequality. The website www.wwp.org.br/en is the disseminating center. The website, in Portuguese, English and Spanish, initially contains texts related to the Brazilian experience, however, it will soon host texts from other countries.
